CURRENT STATUS

The Project was formally launched by Honourable Union Minister of Human Resource Development Shri Kapil Sibal on 4th May, 2010. As on August 5, 2010, a total number of 1296 colleges have registered themselves with the N-LIST program including 783 colleges covered under 12B and 2F Section of the UGC Act.

All e-resources subscribed for colleges under the N-LIST Program are now accessible to these 783 colleges through the N-LIST website.

INDIAN ETD RE-CHRISTENED AS “SHODHGANGA”

The R&D Panel, constituted to review the new initiatives of the INFLIBNET Centre, in its first Meeting, held on 7th June 2010, recommended that a **new, unique and generic name** should be coined for **iETD** (Indian Electronic Theses and Dissertations) that should be easy to pronounce and have greater mnemonic value. Besides, the new name should also reflect Indian philosophy and culture. Accordingly, INFLIBNET Centre invited its *staff and panel* members to suggest a suitable and creative name for this initiative. About **15-20** names came up for consideration, after thorough debate and discussions, the Centre narrowed down to using **'Shodhganga'** A reservoir of Indian Theses' for this initiative.

INDIAN ETD RE-CHRISTENED AS “SHODHGANGA”

The word 'Shodh' originates from Sanskrit and stands for research and discovery. The 'Ganga' is the holiest, longest and largest of all rivers in India. The Ganga is the symbol of India's age-long culture and **civilization, ever changing, ever flowing, ever loved and revered by its people.** "Shodhganga", a repository of theses and dissertations submitted to Indian universities, is expected to keep **growing to a formidable size as more and more researchers submit** their theses to this ever growing reservoir.

ATTACHMENT PROGRAMME (ATP) AT THE INFLIBNET CENTRE

The INFLIBNET Centre launched “Attachment Training Programmes (ATP)” where-in working librarians and computer programmers from North-East can come to the Centre and spend *three to six months* working in the Centre on ongoing projects with experienced INFLIBNET staff. The trained personnel can go back to their Colleges / Universities with knowledge and know-how that they can implement in their libraries.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ATP

1. Young, qualified professionals working in the universities / colleges or other educational institutions having at least **three years of experience** are eligible for the “Attachment Training Programmes (ATP)”.
2. The candidates for “Attachment Training Programmes (ATP)” in **Library Science** should have Master Degree in Library and Information Sciences. Applicants having computer knowledge will be preferred.
3. Candidates for Attachment Training Programmes (ATP) in **Computer Science** should possess BCA, BE(Computer Science / Electronics / Electrical) or MCA.

As such, this initiative of the INFLIBNET Centre successfully fulfils the gap and provides opportunity to faculty and scholars to publish in open access and increase their visibility. Hosting at OJS@ INFLIBNET on open access provides benefits to users, universities and faculty members; thus the overall benefit is extended to the academic community of the country and especially the higher education of the country when the articles get citation internationally, researchers get recognition globally and the journals get high impact factors with the open access publishing.
